



## OFF-LICENCE

31/OFF/006/2020

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

**PURSUANT** to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Skyview Enterprises Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 21 High Street, Waipawa and known as "**Super Liquor Waipawa**", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. If this licence is not endorsed under Section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

### CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 10.00pm**
- (c) Each of the following parts of the premises is designated as a supervised area: **Entire premises**
- (d) At any time that alcohol is being provided free as a sample, drinking water is to be made freely available in the location of the sampling.
- (e) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

### THE LICENSED PREMISES

The sale or delivery of alcohol is authorised in or from the whole of the premises. The premises, situated at 21 High Street, Waipawa, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Central Hawke's Bay District Licensing Agency on 12 August 2020.

### DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S


A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from the car park is designated as the principal entrance.

### DURATION

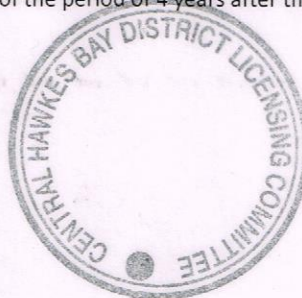
Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force:

- (a) Either:
  - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either:
  - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
